




About 3,4,5-star Resorts

3,4,5-star Resorts in the World

- → 3,4,5-star hotels are primarily used by a range of travellers and tourists including budget, comfort, luxury, and business travellers across the world.
- → Such hotels are essential to the development of a tourist destination allowing tourist across categories to spend additional time at the destination and provides a fillip to the local economy

3,4,5-star Resorts in Gujarat

- → One of the fastest-growing sectors in India is the hotel business, which is projected to expand at a CAGR of 13% between 2023 and 2027. The sector is a key factor in the expansion of India's services sector and is strongly related to the tourist sector.
- → According to the MoT, Gol's India Tourism Statistics 2022, Gujarat is ranked second in terms of the number of 3,4,5-Star hotels approved (61,30,25) and fourth in terms of the maximum number of hotel rooms (9962). Gujarat is also ranked sixth in the
- state-by-state ranking of India's hospitality industry in the 2019 India State Ranking Survey conducted by Hotelivate (Consulting Firm) in collaboration with the World Travel & Tourism Council.
- → The tourism business is steadily expanding and developing in Gujarat. The hotel sector is essential to the travel and tourism sector because it supports local economies by creating jobs and bringing in money for various tourist locations. The map for a potential area near Gujarat's coast is shown below:





Figure 3: Locations for development of proposed 3,4,5-star hotels in Gujarat

- → The hotel industry is a multi-billion-dollar sector and is highly influenced by global economic conditions, travel trends, and consumer behaviour.
- → The hotel industry's growth is closely linked to the global tourism industry. Factors such as increasing disposable income, improved transportation, and easier access to information have led to a rise in international and domestic travel, positively impacting the hotel industry.
- → International hotel chains are expanding in India, and by 2023, they will have a 50% share of the country's tourist and hospitality industry, according to the India Brand Equity Foundation.
- → In India 85% of Five stars hotel rooms are just in 10 states in which Gujarat comes in top five.

- → In October 2022, Indian Hotels Company (IHCL) announced the launch of its new Indian-concept restaurant brand, Loya. Debuting at Taj Palace, New Delhi, Loya captures the culinary essence traversing the landscape of North India.
- → Taj Mahal Palace (Tower) in Colaba, Mumbai, Maharashtra. The hotel is located close to the entrance to India and offers breathtaking views of the Indian Ocean.
- → Malabar Beach in Kerala is home to Somatheeram Ayurvedic Beach Resort. This vintage hotel, which was built close to the shore, offers guests a special chance to relax and rejuvenate through yoga and ayurveda. They exhibit Indian tradition from the outside, yet inside, they are designed with western visitors in mind.

Dharoi

The town of Dharoi is home to the popular tourist attraction known as the Dharoi Dam. The dam is a popular spot for picnics, fishing, and boating. The Dharoi Fort and the Dharoi Wildlife Sanctuary are only two of the numerous tourist attractions that can be found in Dharoi.

Kadana

The Kadana Dam, the Kadana Wildlife Sanctuary, and the Kadana Fort are just a few of the tourist attractions that can be found in Kadana. There is a significant demand for hotels in Kadana as a result of these attractions, which draw visitors from all across India.

Dholavira

An ancient Indus Valley Civilization site called Dholavira is located in the magnificent desert area known as the Rann of Kutch. Animals of many kinds can be found in the area, including flamingos, dolphins, and crocodiles.

Location: Shivrajpur

Nearest railway station is Dwarka, which is around 14 km from Shivrajpur. Shivrajpur is connected to Jamnagar (142 km), Rajkot (236 km), and Ahmedabad (462 km) via the NH-8.

Nearest airport is Jamnagar Airport, which is located at approximately 138 km. Nearest port is the Mandvi Seaport, which is at about 150 km.

Nearest railway station to Beyt Dwarka is Okha Railway Station, which is located about 3km away. NH-8 highway passes through Okha, which is the nearest town to Beyt Dwarka.

Nearest airport is Jamnagar Airport, which is located about 145 kilometers away. Nearest port to Beyt Dwarka is the Okha Port which is about 3 kms away.

Focus of State Government at Potential Destinations

1. Shivrajpur

- → Shivrajpur Beach was awarded the prestigious Blue Flag beach certification in October 2020 by the Denmark based international agency known as the Foundation for Environment Education; which is a Denmark-based voluntary organisation. It is a white sand beach with azure clear water.
- → Based on the proposal submitted to Ministry of Tourism (MoT) by the State Government, MoT included Dwarka as a destination under its flagship Scheme of Swadesh Darshan 2.0, which includes Shivrajpur region.
- → State Government of Gujarat took special initiative to conserve the natural beauty of Shivrajpur, including its beaches, flora, and fauna and also develop the tourist infrastructure to enhance the overall experience of the tourists.
- → Overall Tourism Master Plan has been prepared for Shivrajpur by the State Government with total capital outlay of more than INR 500 Crores to develop the tourist infrastructure.




Figure 4: Overall Tourism Master Plan for Shivrajpur

2. Beyt Dwarka

- → As per mythological studies, Lord Krishna had his kingdom at Dwarka, while Beyt Dwarka's Dwarkadhish temple is said to have been the residence of Lord Krishna during his ruling years at Dwarka.
- → With the Vision to develop Beyt Dwarka as a prominent religious tourism destination & unlock the hidden tourism potentials of the place through eco-sensitive & sustainable design and strategies, State Government took an initiative to prepare the Holistic Master Plan for Beyt Dwarka and identified the projects amounting to more than INR 200 Crores to enhance the overall experience of the tourist visiting Beyt Dwarka.




Figure 6: Overall Tourism Master Plan for Beyt Dwarka

- → Currently, the tourist visiting Beyt Dwarka, access Beyt Dwarka using ferry services from Okha. With the new Signature Bridge over the sea connecting Okha with Beyt Dwarka Island having length of about 2.3 kms under implementation by the State Government, the overall connectivity to Beyt Dwarka island will improve and tourist will able to access the Island in their own vehicles and hence, more number of tourist will be able to visit Beyt Dwarka island.
- → Some of the other nearby tourist destinations to Beyt Dwarka and their major attractions has been mentioned in the table below along with annual footfall observed at those destinations:

3. Mandvi

- → Mandvi is a beach town, which is located along the Arabian Sea in the western part of Gujarat. Mandvi is known for its historical significance, maritime heritage, and vibrant local culture.
- → The Mandvi beach is characterized by its soft golden sands, clear blue waters, and picturesque views of the Arabian Sea. The tranquil and serene atmosphere of Mandvi Beach makes it an ideal place for relaxation, leisurely strolls, and enjoying the natural beauty of the coastline.
- → Mandvi Beach offers options for water sports such as jet skiing, banana boat rides, and parasailing. These activities provide an adventurous and adrenaline-filled experience for those seeking more action-oriented entertainment.
- → In order to boost tourism at Mandvi Beach, State Government initiated the celebration of 2 month long Beach Festival during the months of February, March and April since 2020.
- → Along with 50 beach-side tents of different categories, Beach Festival also features cultural performances, adventure sports and sporting activities
- → Further, to improve the connectivity to Mandvi, the State Government has also taken an initiative to develop the airstrip at Mandvi and a consultant is already engaged by the State Government for the same.
- → Additionally, State Government is also planning to prepare a holistic Tourism Master Plan for Mandvi Beach with an objective to identify tourism related infrastructure requirements.
- → 20,234 sqm land available for development with State government
- → Some of the other nearby tourist destinations to Mandvi and their major attractions has been mentioned in the table below along with annual footfall observed at those destinations:

4. For Gir

- → Gir, located in the Saurashtra region of Gujarat is internationally known for the Gir National Park, which is the only home to the Asiatic Lion and is considered one of the most protected areas in Asia because of its biodiversity.
- → The State government has prepared the master plan for the comprehensive development of Sasan at Gir including development of a Museum of Natural culture and wildlife history, Sculptures & a camp fire site, Cottages, and 360 degree dome projection at Bhal Chel.
- → This development initiative is expected to cost INR 71 crore, of which INR 50 crore has been provisioned in the State Budget for FY 2023-24.

5. Dholavira

- → Dholavira is an ancient archaeological city in the Kutch district of Gujarat. It is one of the five largest Harappan sites and the most prominent of the archaeological sites in India belonging to the Indus Valley Civilization.
- → The site was further declared a "UNESCO World Heritage site" in 2021
- → In FY 2023, Dholavira saw a tourist footfall of about 1.41 lakh visitors.
- → 6,273 sqm land parcel is available for potential development with the State Government
- → The State government has prepared a comprehensive Master Plan for the development of Dholavira which we can see below:




Figure 9: Tourism Master Plan for Dholavira

- → The following developments are planned at each location:
 - → Location A & B: Sculptures and artifacts, Caravan Parking and camp sites
 - → Location C & C1: Parking, 360 virtual reality tourist facilitation centre
 - → Location E: Craft market, food court, plat zone, public plaza, amphitheatre/performance space with laser/light show, and infrastructure for development of tent city
 - → Location F: Cultural Village

→ The total estimated cost of the master plan is estimated to be INR 550 crore and the state budget 2023-24 has provisioned INR 100 crore for the same.

- → Kadana is a village in Mahisagar district of Gujarat located on the banks of Mahi River and if easily accessible by train, bus and flight from Ahmedabad and Baroda.
- → The state government has prepared a Tourism Master Pkan for the village which can be seen below:




Figure 11: Proposed Master Plan for Kadana development

- → TRC, Parking, Hopin Hopoff facility & Tourist facilities along the Road towards dam (75Cr)
- → Development of Night stay & other facilities at various Islands. (100Cr)
- → Development of cliff above the dam location (near the Nadinath Mahadev temple)(40 Cr.)
- → Development of Adventure park. (50 Cr.)
- → Convection Center, Museum development & Digital Forest World (75 Cr)
- → Wildlife Conservation Centre & Sculptures along the Road(50 Cr)
- → Development of Caravan Park (20 Cr)
- \rightarrow Solar Park. (15 Cr.)
- → Permanent Theme Based Lighting (10 Cr.)





- ightarrow The total flow of tourist is expected to record an increase over the years
- ightarrow This is attributed to the growing prominence of the state as a major business hub.
- → Gujarat contributes 6% to the total GSDP in FY23 and is expected to grow by ~6 CAGR till FY25.
- → The business is expanding both in terms of turnover and boundaries and therefore contributions total investments by Gujarat are expected to increase.
- → Gujarat is expected to generate 3 million+ jobs in tourism by 2025.

Incentives offered by the state

Approvals Required

- → Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) approval
- → Acquisition of land from concerned office /owner
- → No objection certificate from Gujarat Pollution Control Board
- → Environmental clearance from Ministry of Environment and Forest and Government of Gujarat (State Impact Assessment Committee)
- → Arrangement of power with zonal distribution company
- → Arrangement of water with concerned municipal corporations
- ightarrow Local body clearances/ Any other clearances required

Government of Gujarat has granted Industry status to Tourism sector to boost the industry.

Incentives offered by the state

Interest subsidy to the eligible tourism units & Service Providers

- → @5% of the loan amount with maximum amount or INR3 lakh per annum for a period of 5 years, whichever is lower in Municipal Corporation areas for eligible tourism units
- → @7% of the loan amount with maximum amount or INR5 lakh per annum for a period of 5 years, whichever is lower in the areas other than mentioned above.

Other Exemptions

- → Luxury Tax 5 years from the date of commencement of commercial operation
- → Entertainment Tax 5 years from the date of commencement of commercial operation
- → 100% exemption from electricity duty for a period of 5 years (New Tourism Projects).
- → 100% reimbursement of stamp duty and registration fee shall be provided to New Tourism Units


Support for Sustainable Tourism

→ Assistance to eligible tourism units up to 50% of the certification fees paid or INR10 Lakh whichever is lower for Green Building Certification to Tourism Project/Units and for Global Sustainable tourism certification it is 50% of the certification fees paid or INR5 lakh whichever is lower.

Special Incentives

Private Player:

→ Capital subsidy of 25% on eligible capital investment for setting up public charging stations for EV, up to 10 lakh
